

RELEVANT INFORMATION

Bogotá D.C., November 30, 2022. Grupo Energía Bogotá S.A. ESP ("GEB") informs that, in compliance with the Share Purchase Agreement entered into on July 29, 2022 ("Agreement") between GEB, its Brazilian subsidiaries, Argo Energia Empreendimentos e Participações S.A. ("Argo") and Gebbras Participações Ltda. ("Gebbras"), with the fund Brasil Energia Fundo de Investimento em Participações Multiestratégia ("Brookfield") to acquire 100% of the common shares of five transmission concessions, the required authorizations were obtained from the regulator Agência Nacional de Energia Elétrica ("ANEEL"), the Brazilian competition authority, the Administrative Council of Economic Defense ("CADE"), and the main concession lenders.

Likewise, compliance with all the conditions precedent stipulated in the Contract was verified, and consequently, to date, Argo and Gebbras, through the investment vehicle "Argeb" (shareholding: 62.5% of Argo and 37.5% of Gebbras), have concluded the process of acquisition of all the common shares of the five concessions, namely Esperanza Transmissora de Energia S.A., Odoyá Transmissora de Energia S.A., Transmissora José Maria de Macedo de Eletricidade S.A., Giovanni Sanguinetti Transmissora de Energia S.A., and Veredas Transmissora de Energia S.A. In order to capitalize the aforementioned companies, GEB entered into a syndicated loan agreement with Bank of Nova Scotia (Scotiabank) and Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation as lead arrangers of the transaction for up to USD 509 million with a term of five (5) years and amortization at maturity.

With the acquisition of these assets, Argo increases its size, which currently amounts to 1,743 km of transmission lines. 743 km of 500 kV and 230 kV transmission lines and 13 fully operational substations in the states of Ceará, Maranhão, Minas Gerais, Pernambuco, Piauí and Rondônia, and position itself as one of the leading transmitters in Brazil's electric power market, adding 2. 416 km of 500 kV and 230 kV transmission lines, 22 substations in the states of Bahia, Ceará, Minas Gerais, Paraíba, Piauí and Rio Grande do Norte, one of the areas with the greatest renewable energy potential and transmission grid development needs in Brazil.
