Issue	Defitions
Climate Change	Manage the risks and opportunities of climate change (mitigation, adaptation), develop actions focused on energy system transformation and generate economic benefits through strategies that consider and address the challenges of climate change.
Biodiversity	Development of actions focused on the protection and conservation of biodiversity and ecosystem services in the areas of operation of GEB and its subsidiaries, including strategies based on the mitigation hierarchy (avoid, minimise, rehabilitate/restore and compensate).
Environmental performance	Definition and implementation of strategies to prevent, mitigate, correct and/or compensate for negative environmental impacts generated by the GEB activities and its subsidiaries throughout its value chain. In addition, it includes the efficient use of natural resources, air quality, energy, water and waste management.
Energy transition	Prioritize investment in renewable energy generation projects (solar, wind), and develop strategies focused on energy transition (from fossil fuels to renewables, reduction of carbon emissions into the atmosphere).
Shared Prosperity	Improvement of the conditions of progress and social development in the communities in the area of operation of GEB and its subsidiaries, based on actions focused on the creation of mutual benefits.
